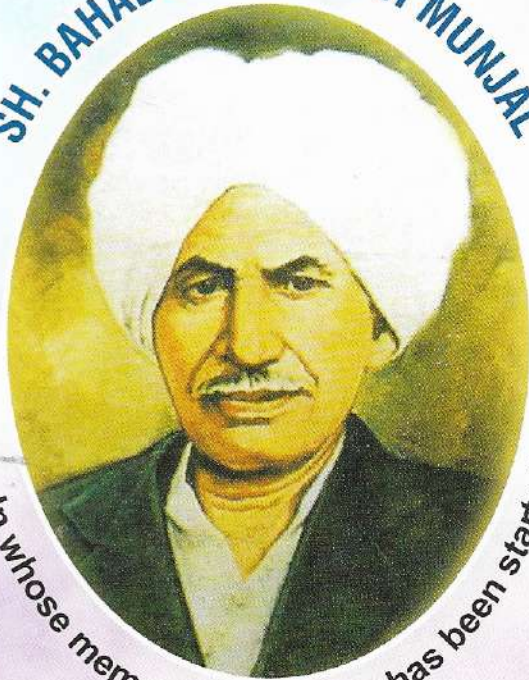

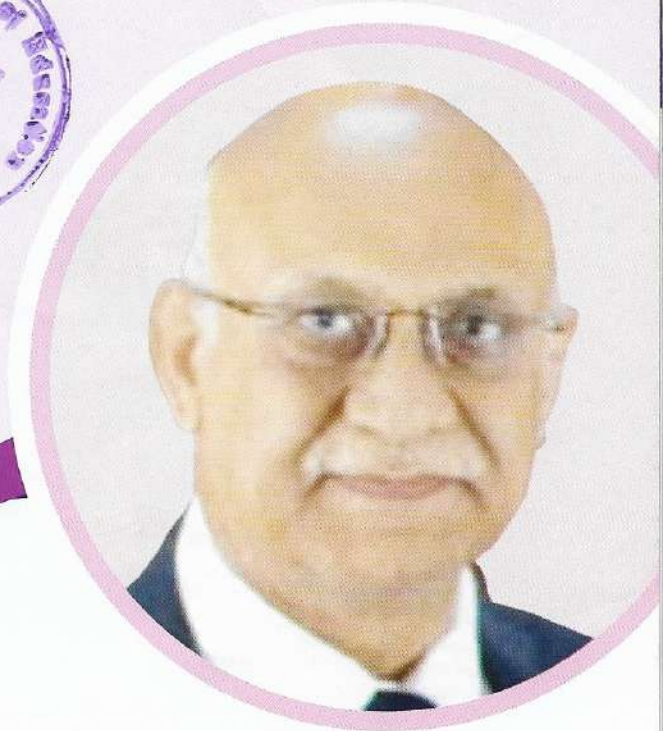

B.C.M. stands for Sh. Bahadur Chand Munjal (1886-1960) in whose sacred memory the College was established in 1998 by LBCM Foundation. The College was a dream of Mahatma Satyanand Ji Munjal with the vision of Achieving Inclusive Education and Transforming Society. The college is offering B.Ed. course (150 seats), M.Ed. course (50 seats) and B.Ed. Special Education-Learning Disability course (30 seats) and is recognized by UGC under section 2(f) & 12(B) of University Grant Commission Act 1956, National Council for Teacher Education, Panjab University, Chandigarh and RCI, New Delhi. The college is accredited by NAAC with grade 'A'. NCERT, Delhi has awarded the college twice for innovative practices in the field of Teacher Education.

Apart from B.C.M. College of Education, LBCM Foundation is running four schools in different part of the city to serve the purpose of education in society.

HISOTRY

B.C.M. is the first education college of Punjab under self finance scheme. Prior to the establishment of this College, Ludhiana City had only one B.Ed. College for Women only and that too had 70% seats reserved for rural women.

B.C.M. College began with an initial intake of 60 seats to produce efficient and dedicated teachers who worked under the guidance of renowned and seasoned educationist Dr. S.K. Nanda, Founder Principal of the College. The number of seats rose to 120 in the very next year, to 180 in 2003 and the number further went upto 280 in 2008. The College got permanent affiliation to Panjab University, Chandigarh in 2004. The M.Ed., course was started from session 2007-08. From the session 2014-15, the college started B.Ed. Special Education course (Learning Disability) with 25 seats approved by Rehabilitation Council of India vide letter No. 17-627 / B.Ed. (LD) / 13 / RCI. This phenomenal rise clearly indicated the commitment of management and faculty which provides an environment of belongingness and democratic work culture.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The College is ideally located in open and pollution free area on Chandigarh Road, Sector 32-A, Urban Estate, Near Samrala Chowk, Ludhiana. Class Rooms

We have well equipped Language lab which can serve the purpose of practical of Phonetics as clarity and accuracy of language gives confidence to the learner and open doors for literary skills.

Apart from these, we regularly subscribe 14 Newspapers, 31 Journals and 21 Magazines. For meritorious and economically backward students Book Bank facility is available. Mathematics Laboratory

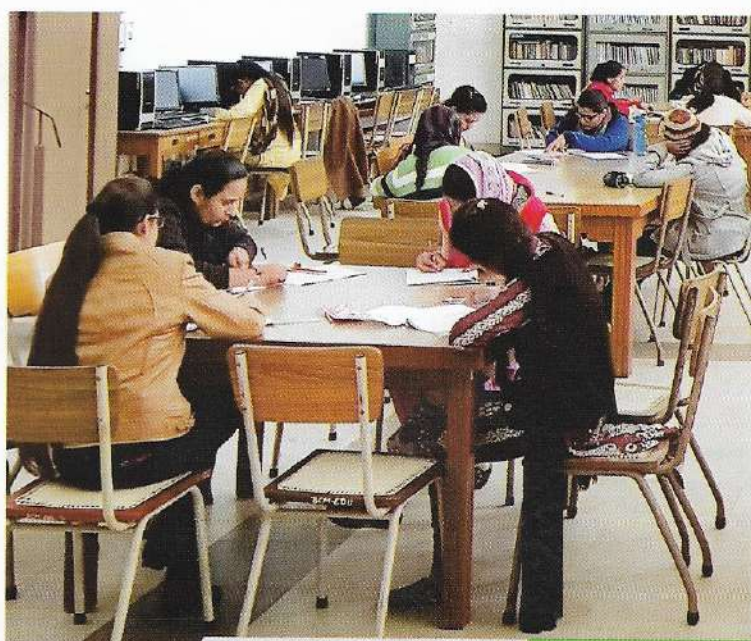

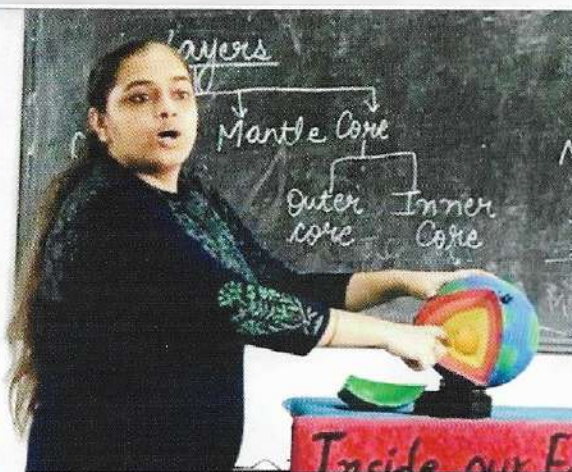
Home Science Laboratory

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Eligibility for admission to M.Ed. Course

A degree in Bachelor of Education / Equivalent degree of this University with 50% marks (45% in case SC / ST / BC candidates) or from any other University / Institutions recognized by AIU or B.A. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. (50%) or B.El.Ed. (50%) or D.El.Ed. with an undergraduate degree (with 50% marks).

Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PwD and other applicable categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government / State Government whichever is applicable.

Admission procedure for M.Ed.

Admission to the M.Ed. Course 1st year (50 seats) shall be made according to the guidelines framed by the Panjab University, Chandigarh.

2. Eligibility for Admission Procedure for B.Ed. course

- Candidates with atleast 50% Marks either in Bachelor's degree and / or in the Master's degree in Science / Social Sciences / Humanities / Commerce / Home Science/ B.B.A/ B.C.A/ Engineering / Technology or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the B.Ed. programme. However, while calculating merit, marks obtained in Graduation only will be considered.
- Candidates should have passed Graduation / Post-Graduation in a relevant school subjects.

- A candidate getting admission on the basis of Post Graduate Degree shall have to opt for one of teaching subjects pursued by him/her at Master degree.

Note :

- a. Any candidate with less than 50% or less marks would not be eligible.
- b. Any candidate who has passed Graduation without a relevant school subject would not be considered.
- c. There shall be a relaxation of 5% marks in favour of SC/ST/PwD candidates. Candidate with less than 45% marks belonging to these categories shall not be eligible. PwD candidates shall be eligible for relaxation provided that they produce a medical certificate that they have at least 40% physical disability.

Admission procedure for B.Ed.

- a. Admission to the B.Ed. course shall be made according to the guideline framed by the Panjab University/ Punjab Govt. Chandigarh.
- b. There are a total of 150 seats for B.Ed. Course 1st year of Panjab University in this college. Out of the total 19 seats will be filled under management quota as per the Punjab Govt. / Panjab University norms.
- c. The management quota seats will be filled according to the Punjab Govt. directions. Students willing to get admission to management quota seats will have to apply to the college directly.

3. Eligibility for Admission to B.Ed. Special Education (Learning Disability) 1st Year

The admission to the course shall be open to all the eligible candidates. 85% seats will be reserved for the candidates from within the state and 15% will be open to candidates of other states on all India Basis.

Admission Procedure for B.Ed. Special Education [LD]

Admission to the B.Ed, special education course shall be made strictly according to rules/guidelines framed by RC/Panjab University/ Punjab Government.

4. Important information regarding original documents to be shown at the college at the time of admission:

- Hard copy of duly filled online admission form
- Copies of mark sheets of qualifying examinations
- Copy of matriculation certificate for proof of date of birth
- Copy/Copies of certificate for claiming seat against reserve category (if any)
- Copy of certificate/s supporting the claims for weightages (as per guidelines displayed on PU website)
- Character Certificate (from the institute last attended)
- Domicile certificate for claiming Punjab Quota as per latest direction of Punjab Government.

Note : Attach photocopies of all certificates with application form.

5. Fee :

The Fee for B. Ed. General, B.Ed. Special Education and M.Ed, regular course will be as fixed by Punjab Govt. / Panjab University. It may be changed without notice under the instructions from Panjab University/ Punjab Govt.

6. Payment of Fees

The dates of Payments of dues will be notified from time to time according to the following Schedule :

- The Fee is to be paid in College office after online allotment of seat.
- Examination fees is to be paid as per Panjab university guidelines in all semesters.
- The candidates who fail to deposit fee on due date will have no claim for admission.
- Fine will be charged for payment of fee after stipulated time.
- Students who have passed their lower examination from University other than Panjab University will have to submit 'MIGRATION CERTIFICATE'.

Important

Migration Certificate in Original and Original Detail marks card of last class passed has to be submitted in the College office within 30 days of admission failing which students will have to pay late registration fee to Panjab University, Chandigarh as per the rules and instructions of PU. Chandigarh.

7. General Rules

- All the students are require to dress up modestly. Wearing of all kinds of gold or diamond ornaments is discouraged.
- Student must have their identity cards during working hour of the college.
- House Test:
 - a) Appearing in Unit Test & House Test is must. It is compulsory for all the students to appear in both the tests.

- Strict disciplinary action will be taken against those who absent themselves from House Examination
- Students will have to secure at least 40% marks in each examination or else they will not be allowed to appear in the final examination.
- Any student who fails or absents even from one paper, for what-so-ever reason, will not be entitled to academic prizes.
- No students will be allowed to accept employment during the course of study.

The College will appreciate your participation in various activities. The Principal and staff reserve the right to frame new rules and the same shall come into force immediately. Make it your habit to see the College Notice Board daily.

8. Attendance

Minimum attendance of Student Teachers shall be 80% for all course work and practicum and 90% for school internship. Leave taken on any ground during the academic session does not help the student in condonation of lectures. So students who take leave even on medical grounds are at the risk of lecture shortage. The lecture shortage will be displayed on the notice board.

9. Leave Rules

- Student is required to get his / her leave sanctioned from tutorial incharges.
- Application must be signed by the parents guardian.
- Medical Certificate should be attached with in case of medical.
- Group tutor can sanction the leave upto 3 days.

10. Uniform (Tuesday & Friday):

1. Girls : Skin Colour Suit, Brown Dupatta, Brown cardigan/ Brown Shawl for Winter.
2. Boys : Skin Colour Shirt, Brown Trousers, Brown Turban, Brown Sweater for winters.

LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Rules

1. Enter your name and sign in the register kept at the entrance counter before entering Library.

2. Silence to be maintained.
3. No discussion permitted inside the library.
4. No personal belongings allowed inside the library.
5. Textbooks, printed materials and issued book are not allowed to be taken inside the library.
6. Using Cellular phones is strictly prohibited in the library premises.
7. Show the books and other materials which are being taken out of the library to the staff at the entrance Counter.
8. Reader should not mark, underline, write, tear pages or otherwise damage the library materials.

Circulation Rules (Issue & Return)

Cyber Library Rules

1. Our Library is fully classified, computerized and library has open access system, user can access their information through catalogue which is available in Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) and Manual subject catalogue.
2. Three Books (2 textbooks + 1 General book) will be issued to B.Ed. Students & Six Books (5 textbook + 1 General Book) will be issued to M.Ed. Students and 4 books (3 textbooks + 1 General Book) will be issued to B.Ed. Special L/D students at a time for period of 15 days.
3. If required after the fortnight, the book can be renewed. The Books will be renewed at the discretion of the librarian for the same period, but not more than once.
4. The books should be returned within the stipulated time, otherwise fine will be imposed on the defaulters.
5. The book lost shall be either replaced by the latest edition plus 10% of the price as service charges. In case the book is out of print or rare its latest price is not available, the Librarian will decide the amount to be charged.

- Cyber Library is to be used for academic purpose only.
- Browsing of social networking sites is strictly prohibited in the cyber library.
- Members must take care of their Pen drives / CD /DVD discs.

Photostats Library Rules

The material to be photocopied will not be collected after 11:00 am and photocopies will be provided afternoon.

Advance payment will have to be deposited in the library. Dissertation or Bind Journals will not be photocopied.

1. The hostel authorities will not be responsible for any incident during the outing hours / visit to home or local guardian.





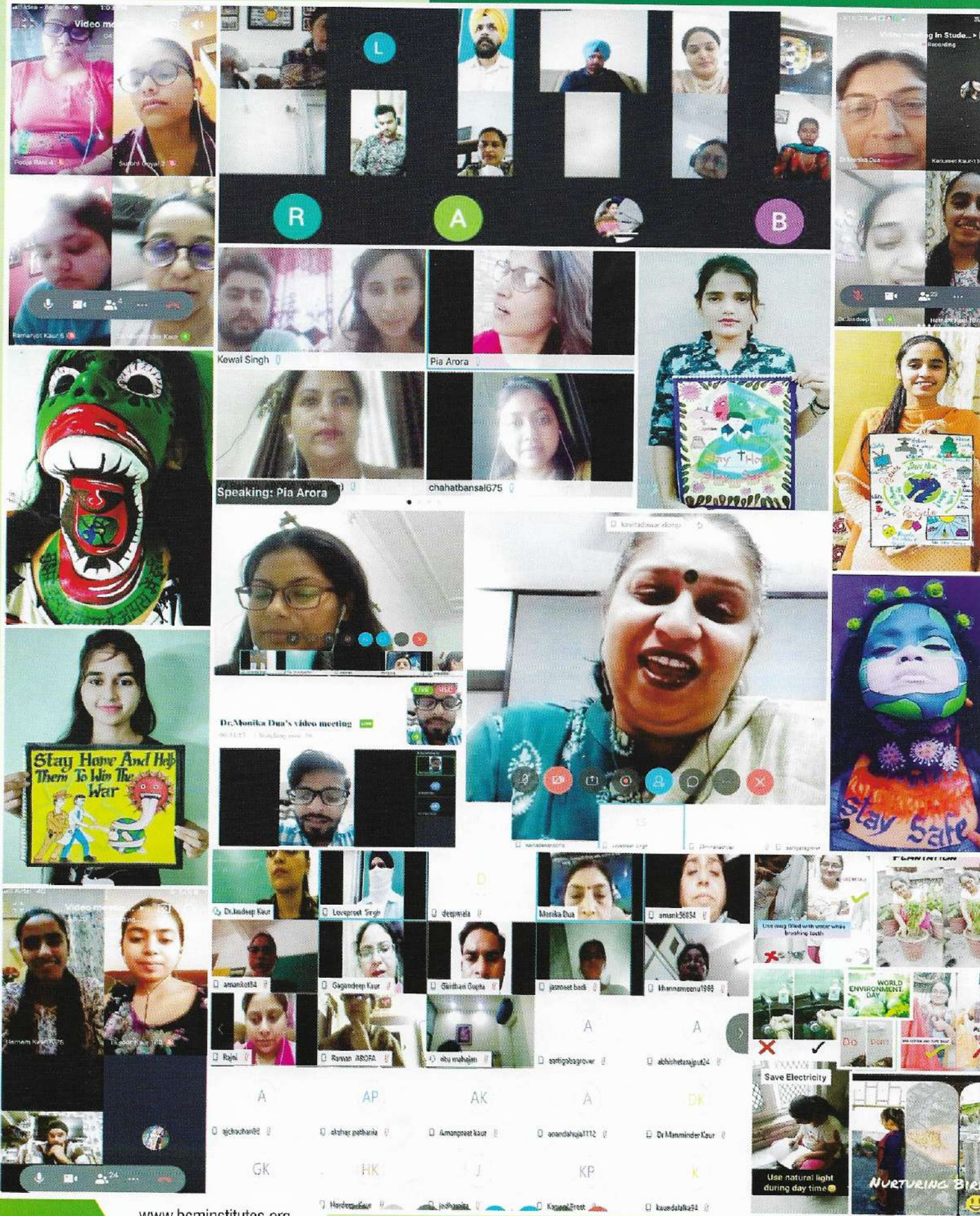
2. Each dormitory will be allotted to three students.
